

How Does COVID-19 Affect Pets?

1. TREAT PETS AS YOU WOULD OTHER HUMAN



A small number of dogs and cats have been reported to spread the virus to and from humans. Pets need to keep their social distancing when interacting with people or other animals outside the household.

2. HOW TO SOCIAL DISTANCE?

Keep cats indoor to prevent interaction. When walking dogs outside, make sure they are on a leash and keep them 6 feet apart from others. Lastly, avoid public areas with large number of people and animals.



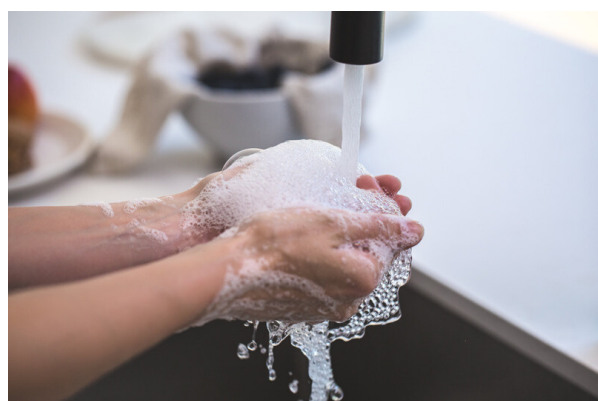
2. PROTECT PETS IF YOU ARE SICK

If you are sick, restrict yourself from being in contact with your pet or other animals. When you and your pet are both sick, do not go straight to the vet, but give vet a call first to see if telemedicine is an option.



3. PET HYGIENE

Wash your hands after handling animals, their food, supplies, and waste. Remember, children younger than 5 years, elders older than 65 years, and immunocompromised patients have higher risk of getting sick from germs animals carry



4. PETS WITH COVID-19

Symptoms of pets sick with COVID-19 include fever, coughing, shortness of breath, and more. If they show these signs, immediately contact the veterinarian. But always remember, prevention is the key.
